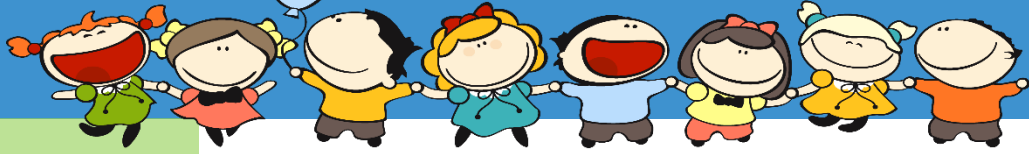

The new space will be called Page's Playground in honor of Page Daniel Hill, who served as Preschool Director and teacher at St. Paul's for 15 years.

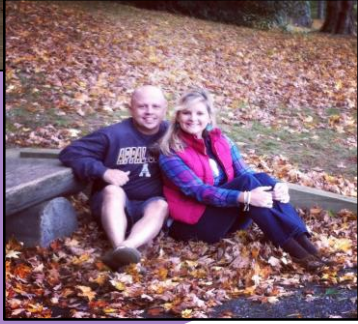
