Maximum registration fee per family: \$300.00. Make checks payable to *St. Paul's Preschool*. Credit cards accepted (see below).

To enroll in the Readiness class, a child must be 5 years of age by August 31, 2020

All children enrolled in Readiness will be charged a Shop Fee of \$100/year, due by September 15, 2020.

The Readiness class has a lower teacher to child ratio, thus allowing more one-on-one time for each child. The curriculum includes preschool activities, preparation for kindergarten, and occasional fieldtrips to local destinations. The extra hour in Readiness is to help prepare students for the longer day when they go to Kindergarten. Students in Readiness bring their lunch every day and eat together as a class. They may sign up for extra-curricular classes during Lunch Bunch if you choose to. In this case, they would eat lunch with the class and then go to their extra-curricular from 12:20-12:50. Fees for these classes would still apply and be paid to the person or organization teaching it.

In order to guarantee your place, the first month's, September tuition, non-refundable tuition is due no later than May 15, 2020 (or upon registration at a later date). Tuition is paid one month in advance. **Registration fees are non-refundable. Overdue tuition fees- SPP will charge a 10% late fee to your account if your tuition is greater than 30 days overdue.**

NEWCOMERS PLEASE NOTE—St. Paul's Preschool welcomes families in our community who are not currently or previously affiliated with our church or preschool. You are welcome to arrange a tour of the preschool in advance by contacting the preschool office at knorris@stpauls-ws.org or 336-723-4395. This pre-enrollment worksheet and points tabulation (below) does not apply for newcomers. Openings within the preschool (after affiliated persons have priority registration) will be available for other interested applicants to register on Monday, February 24, 2020 beginning at 8:00 AM. Registration forms may be dropped off in the Preschool Office any time that morning (see box below).

[Non-affiliated out-of-town applications plus registration fees may be mailed (postmarked by February 14, 2020). Email by the same date is an option when paying by credit card. In situations where individuals are moving to Winston-Salem at a later date and are currently living out of town, applications will be processed immediately after those of applicants in line at 8:00 AM on Feb.25, 2020.]

SPP Registration Worksheet

Thank you for completing the following worksheet to determine your rank for placement in the St. Paul's Preschool registration process. Once the information provided has been confirmed and applications have been reviewed, class assignments will be made in order of point totals. Active parishioners of St. Paul's Episcopal Church will receive priority based on length of membership (see below). As always, any child currently enrolled at St. Paul's Preschool is guaranteed a space (not necessarily first choice) for the 2020/2021 school year.

Every effort will be made to accommodate your wishes and the needs of your children. An attempt will be made to equalize the number of boys and girls in a class, and this may cause the point count to be out of order. Days for Tiny Tots will be matched with those of older siblings. The preschool director, assisted by teachers and/or board members, will determine overall placement. In the event of a tie for one remaining space in a class, the following facts (in this order) will be used to determine placement: 1) Total number of years the family has been at St. Paul's Preschool, 2) Parent is a St. Paul's Preschool alum, 3) Child has siblings currently enrolled at SPP, and 4) Child enrolling had a sibling previously enrolled in the class.
